Text SGSG01 (followed by the amount that you want to donate) to 70070. For example: SGSG01£10

- You will be given the option to Gift Aid your donation.
- No additional charges apply – just your standard tariff.

# Growing Ministry

It costs around £2,100 per day to keep our churches staffed, open and running – this is only possible because of regular donations.

In order to deepen and grow God's Kingdom in Ashted, we seek to develop our ministry and service to the community. Here are a few examples of ministry that your giving has enabled:

- The building of a Prayer garden at the Dell centre
- 10% of the regular giving is used to support our mission partners, both in the UK and internationally
- 15 weekly groups for young people between the ages of 0 and 18 and a range of subsidised activities including being able to offer a holiday club and residential trips at a reduced cost.
- The introduction of a regular Messy Church for primary aged children and their carers
- Training new ordinands and Pastoral Care Assistants
- Supporting the Ashted Churches Together initiative to house a refugee family in Ashted
- Essential maintenance and improvements to our churches and halls including window and roof repairs, reflooring and redecoration.
- Upgrading of sound and visual equipment to support our services
